CTRAd Workstream Members

We are seeking individuals with significant contribution in their fields (whether clinical, non-clinical, industry, academic or in related health services) who have the commitment and enthusiasm to work with CTRAd to strengthen radiotherapy research at a national level. Workstream members are being sought for all four workstreams:

Workstream 1: Science Base

Workstream 2: Phase I/II trials

Workstream 3: Phase III trials and Methodologies

Workstream 4: New Technology, Physics and Quality Assurance

Each workstream has its own objectives and deliverables, and is led by two co-chairs drawn from different disciplines who will work closely with the Chair, Deputy Chair and a dedicated programme manager to drive forward innovative research in radiotherapy. The role requires preparatory work and attendance at both face-to-face and teleconference meetings. Project specific workpackages will also require input from Workstream Members, who will have opportunities to contribute and lead according to their expertise.

Applications will be reviewed by the CTRAd Chair and/or Deputy Chair, Workstream co-chairs and the NCRI Executive, and a decision made at a review panel teleconference. No interviews will be held.
